Documents needed for completion of Application and Registration to the NFTO Chamber of EFTA

- 1. NFTO <u>Application Form</u> signed by President and Secretary of the applying association and stamped with association's stamp addressed to the NFTO Chair
- 2. Minutes of the <u>General Assembly</u> of the applying association agreeing on becoming a member of the NFTO Chamber of EFTA, certified by the signature of the President and the Secretary of the Association. The document must be sent in the original language with an English translation included.
- 3. A Statement of the <u>Board</u>, agreeing on the procedures of becoming a member of the NFTO Chamber of EFTA, certified by the signature of the President and the Secretary of the Association. The document must be sent in the original language with an English translation included.
- 4. A copy of the <u>Statutes</u> of the Organisation, certified by the signature of the President and the Secretary of the Association. The document must be sent in the original language with an English translation included of at least those parts of the statuses referring to:
- → Name, aims and fields of activity.
- → Declaration on being a non -profit association.
- Accreditation Criteria for Family Therapists. (If the Organisation does not have Accreditation Criteria it must include the part of the Statutes that describes the specific characteristics of the association and its members).
- 5. Code of Ethics
- 6. A list of members that states:
- ightarrow Name, complete address, educational degree and title, level of accreditation.
- → If this is not possible, a description of the membership must be enclosed, stating: Number of members (in each level of accreditation), educational degrees and titles represented and other characteristics that describe the composition of the association.
- 7. Completion of the <u>Data Form</u>, Sections I and II (you can find it on the website)
- 8. Payment of the registration fee for the current year

All these documents (on PDF files) have to be sent to the NFTO Chair.
